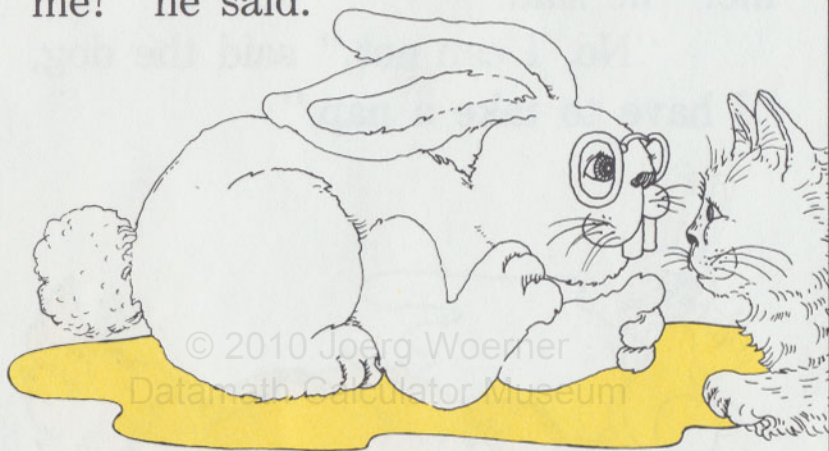
Come and Play

“Who can I play with?”

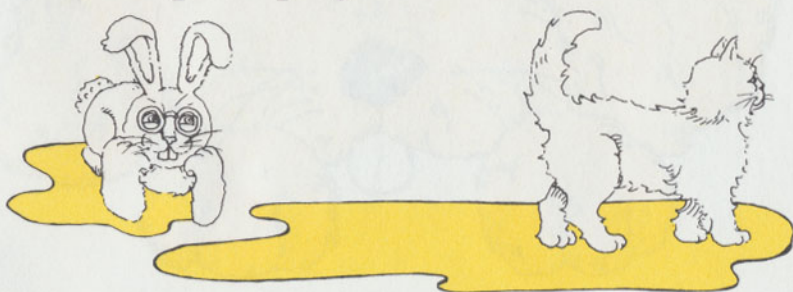


He saw a cat.

fun?



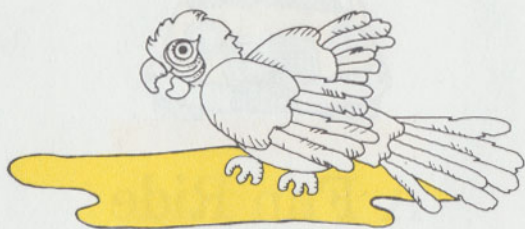
A Fun Ride

“OK,” said Wordy Bird.



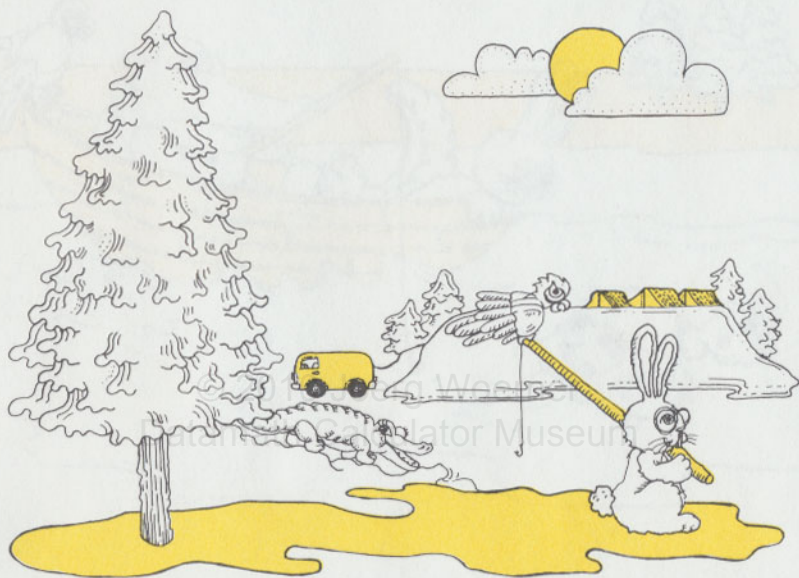
“Where will we go?” said Reader Rabbit.

“Good,” said Wordy Bird, and they went in the van.



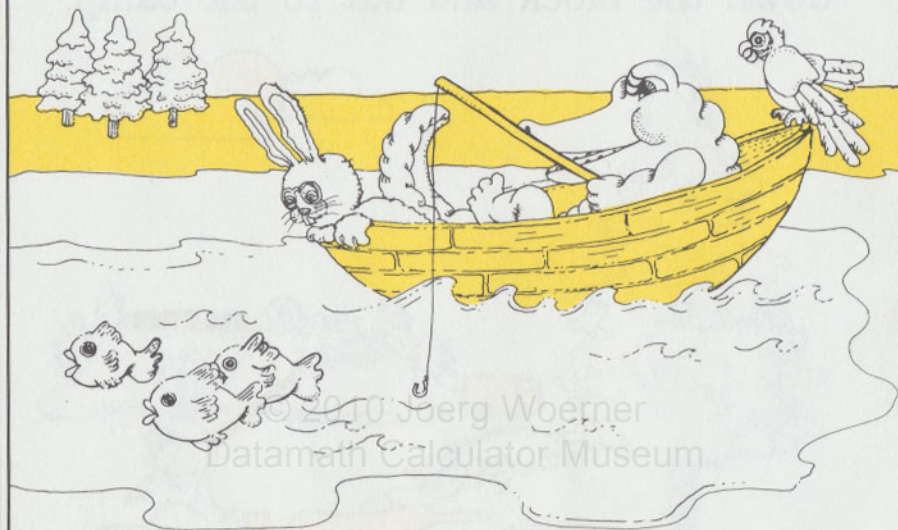
The van went fast. They went down the block and out to the camp.

“What is wrong?” said Pam.

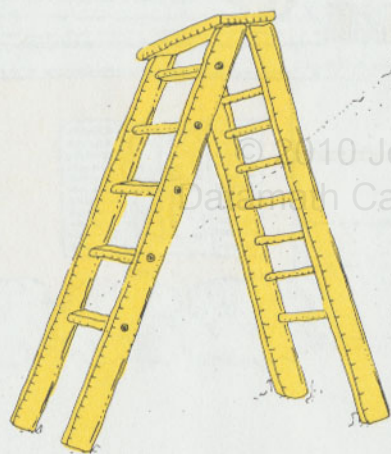



“Look,” said Pat. “My cap is up there. How can I get it down?”

So she went to see Reader Rabbit.

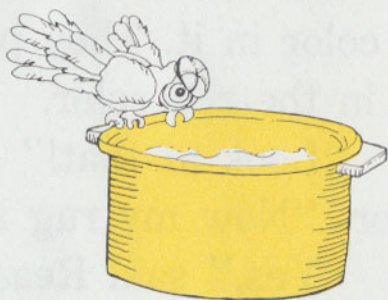
Reader Rabbit had a pot with red color in it. They put the yellow rug in the red color.

“Yes,” said Reader Rabbit. “Yellow and red make orange.”



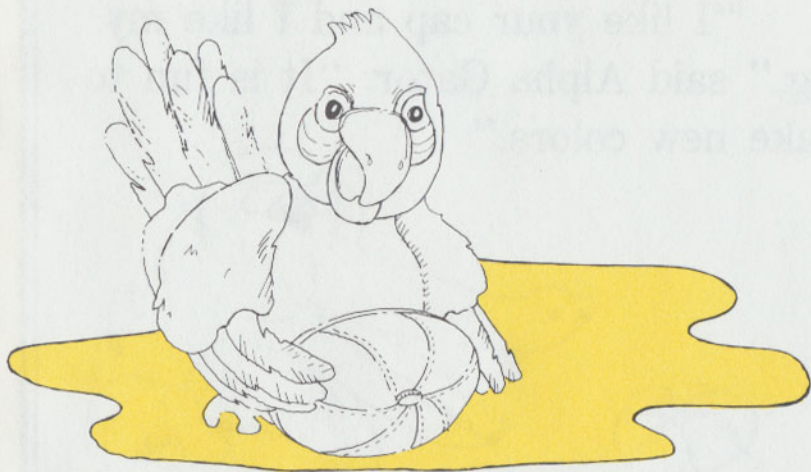
Wordy Bird came in and saw the pot with the red color in it.

“Look at my rug. It was yellow but now it is this pretty orange color.”





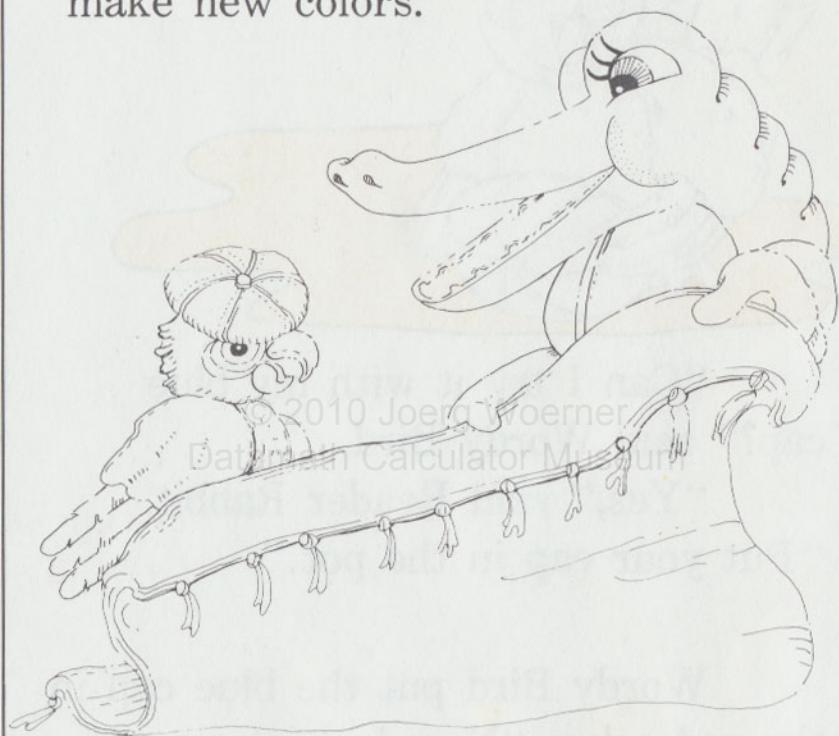
“Can I try it with my blue cap?” said Wordy Bird.

“I like your cap and I like my rug,” said Alpha Gator. “It is fun to make new colors.”



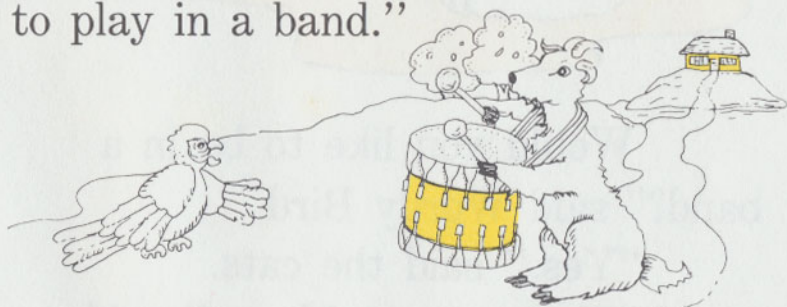

“Yes,” said the rams.



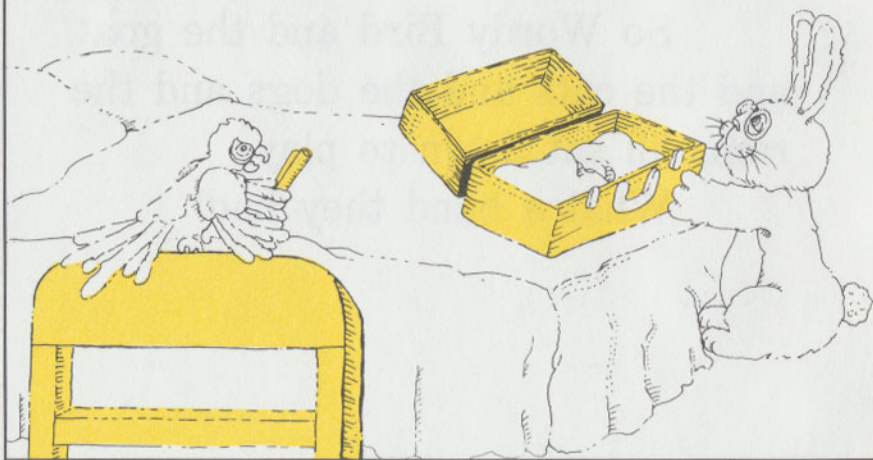
So Wordy Bird and the goat

What a band they had!

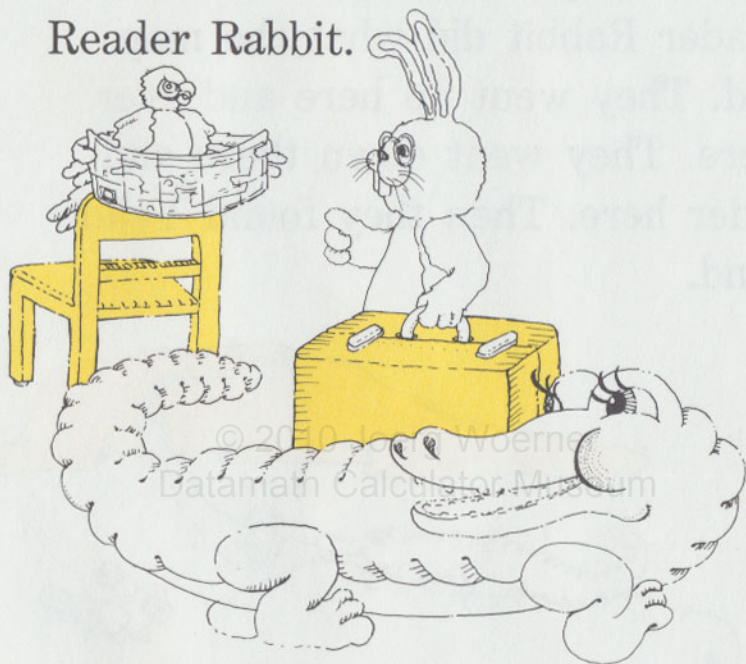


The Trip to Yellow Land

“What is Yellow Land?” said Reader Rabbit.

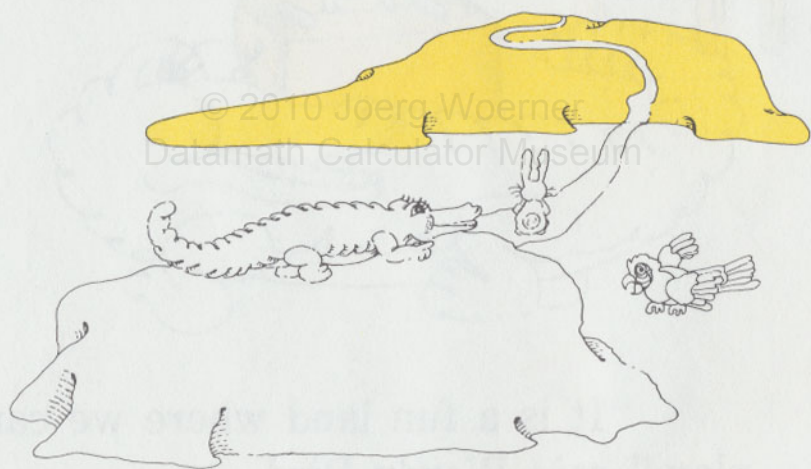


“It is a fun land where we can play,” said Wordy Bird.

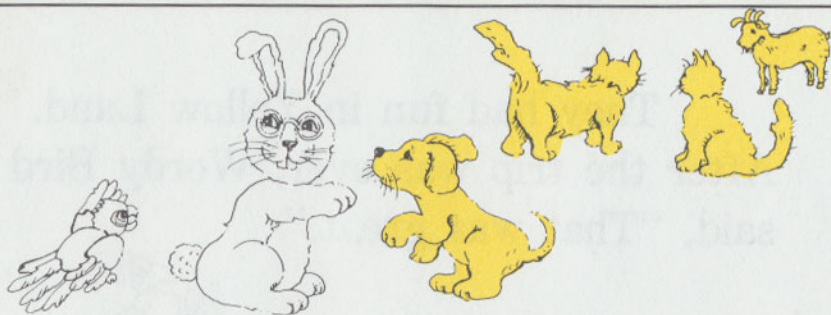
“Great!” said Alpha Gator.

Wordy Bird, Alpha Gator, and Reader Rabbit did what the map said. They went up here and over there. They went down there and under here. Then they found Yellow Land.

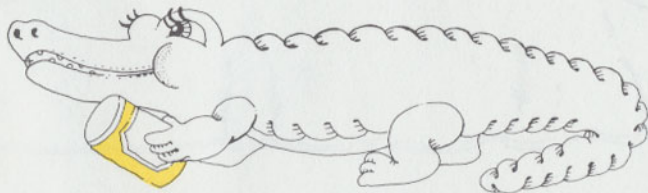


“Look,” said Alpha Gator. “All the land looks yellow!”



“I want to play with the yellow animals,” said Reader Rabbit.

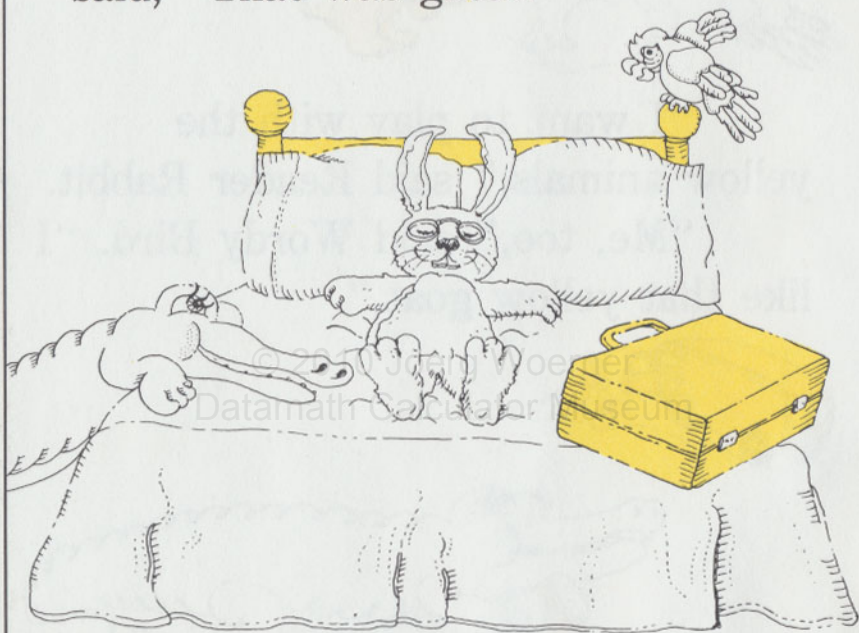
“Me, too,” said Wordy Bird. “I like that yellow goat.”

"But I like home, too!"

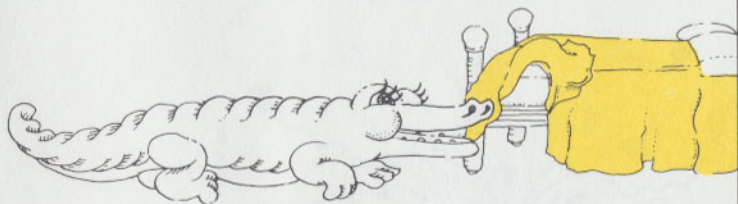
